ARCHIPAROCHI dataset- In the context of the research program ARCHIPAROCHI, my team and I have created an extensive archive, hosted at the History and Theory of Architecture Laboratory, School of Architecture, NTUA, for the benefit of future researchers. The archive comprises the following components: a. 35 entries from parliamentary discussions spanning the years 1946-1967, which are related to housing policies, regulations, and the prevalent political discourse of that era concerning the building sector and related topics;

b. a systematic index of daily and specialized press articles from the period 1949-1974, including more than 700 classified advertisements; c. a collection of 30 interviews, each lasting one to three hours, conducted using the semi-structured guide (oral history) method between February 2019 and February 2020 (fully transcribed into text); d. almost 3,000 approved building permits for 'polykatoikía' buildings in the years 1955, 1960, 1965, and 1970, published in the newspapers Nauteboriki and Express (recorded and geocoded); e. an extensive archive comprising more than 470 digitized architectural drawings and plans discovered after an exhaustive two-year research effort in Athenian architectural offices. Research conducted at architectural offices revealed previously unknown aspects of architects' everyday practices during the period from 1935 to 1975. The examination of building permits, which had not been attempted before, provided new insights into visualizing the historical evolution of the phenomenon. This research's findings were presented to the public during the one-day conference titled Antiparochi and (its) Architects held in Athens on March 2, 2022 (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=myBzOA6zyLo, https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=k2xL7srgotM).
